Vintage Conditions

2021 was a long and consistent vintage. Not too hot, with rain at the perfect times. We picked from late February to Mid-April, and bunches were consistent and uniform with fruit quality super high.

Winemaking

Picked from parcels of F4V6 clone and rushed straight to be pressed. Cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks coupled with the specific clone provides crisp fruit with a fresh steely backbone
